



Cat Urine

Ez-clean is live bioenzyme product that requires moisture and time to work. Imagine that moisture is the highway in which ez-clean travels. This enables the enzymes to move around and find the organics. The longer it sits in a moist environment, the better your results will be.

Application of ez-clean

Litter Boxes :

The plastic that litter boxes are made of is porous, so smells linger even with fresh litter. Ez-clean takes care of those underlying odors.

- Empty the litter box completely, then spray ez-clean full strength in the box. Leave to dry, add fresh cat litter, then top it with another spray of ez-clean. The box will stay fresher, longer. Re-spray with ez-clean as required.

Urine in Carpet / Marking Around the House :

If chemicals were previously used to try to clean the stain, you **must** rehydrate the stain with water and blot dry to remove any residual chemical that may still be on the stain.

- If dry urine is found, prewet the area with water. If fresh, blot any excess liquid and remove solids.
- Apply ez-clean full strength, and keep the area moist. If you think the area will dry too quickly before it has time to work, try applying a piece of plastic wrap over the area and use a book to hold it in place.
- Once ez-clean is applied to a stain, walk away and leave it to dry completely. It's life cycle is now complete.
- For heavily soiled areas, a 2nd application may be required.

Additional Information

- Ez-clean may also be used in planters. Simply dilute ez-clean in a watering can 1:10 and soak the plant. We recommend doing this overnight so the dirt stays moist for longer, as opposed to drying out in the sunlight. It is safe for plants and seeds.
Once diluted the product will only stay alive for two weeks, so only mix what you need. A 2nd application may be required.
